All staff set professional learning goals and participate in professional development to improve their instructional skills.

Student achievement in the areas of reading, math and science as measured by NeSA tests has improved over time

Celebrations from 2012-2013 Goals

Data review of ITBS Grade 3 data in the area of Total Math and Total Reading indicated and increase of 2-7 Mean NCE percentile points.

Data review of Grades 3-5 NeSA indicated a 3% growth in Reading, 10% growth in Math, and 8% growth in Science from 2012 to 2013.
