Celebrations from 2012-2013 Goals

94% of fifth grade students met or exceeded state standards in reading, more than 71% of these students <u>exceeded</u> standards!

93% of fourth grade students met or exceeded math standards during the 2012-2013 school year! All subtests of the Iowa Test of Basic Skills administered in October of 2012 show Hill School students scoring at or above district averages!
