All staff participate in school wide Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports to create a positive and supportive school climate for students.

Celebrations from 2012-2013 Goals

44% of students MET proficiency and 47% of students EXCEEDED_on the NeSA Reading Assessment.

49% of students MET proficiency and 40% EXCEEDED on the NeSA Math Assessment.

Student Achievement on the NeSA Science Assessment improved by 17% from 71% to 88% proficient.
