School Improvement Most Important Points

- Teachers at Huntington use the Leadership and Learning Data Team protocol within the continuous improvement model.
- Our Community Learning Center program is imbedded within the School Improvement model.
 - Teachers at Huntington collaborate at high levels and embrace the teaming approach.

Celebrations from 2012-2013 Goals

- 75% of 3rd graders passed the NeSA math assessment while 86% of the females passed the same assessment.
- The percentage of 4th graders passing the NesA Reading assessment has steadily increased each of the 4 years with 69% of 4th graders passing.
- 94% of the parents surveyed consider Huntington as a "Community School" that reaches out to meet the needs of their families.
