School Improvement Most Important Points

All staff work collaboratively in high functioning Professional Learning Communities to meet grade-level specific goals related to the building school improvement goals.

Student progress is analyzed and appropriate interventions are determined on a weekly basis by grade level teams.

All staff engage in on-going professional development to acquire and refine effective instructional skills and strategies.

Celebrations from 2012-2013 Goals

- 95% of Kloefkorn 3rd grade students met or exceeded state standards in Reading and Math on the NeSA assessments, compared to 83% at the district and 77% at the state levels.
- 98% of Kloefkorn 4th grade students met or exceeded state standards in Reading and Math and 94% met or exceeded standards in Writing on the NeSA assessments, compared to 83% in Reading, 77% in Math, and 75% in Writing at the district level and 79% in Reading, 72% in Math, and 69% in Writing at the state level.
- 95% of Kloefkorn 5th grade students met or exceeded standards in Reading, and 86% met or exceeded in Math and Science, compared to 83% in Reading, 79% in Math, and 66% in Science at the district level and 78% in Reading, 75% in Math, and 68% in Science at the state level.
