LNS Teachers' Writing Institute, representing all disciplines, is currently developing a framework for writing across the curriculum.

Celebrations from 2012-2013 Goals

We continue to celebrate an increased graduation rate each year with last year reaching 81.7 %.

Both Science and Writing NeSA scores continue to increase with Writing increasing by 10% last year.

We continue to help all students find connections to school knowing that this makes an increased graduation rate more likely to continue to climb. Lincoln North Star High School is currently the only high school in the state that has a Community Learning Center. We have had a steady increase of student involvement over the past 3 years.
