School Improvement Most Important Points

- All staff focus on school improvement goals and individual student interventions through their collaboration during PLC weekly meetings
- All staff set professional learning appraisal goals and participate in professional development to improve their instructional skills
 - Lux demographics have changed and will change
 - Enrollment is at an all-time high
- PLC groups will focus on sub-groups who have not met AYP goals (special education and free-reduced lunch). The free and reduced lunch subgroup did not meet AYP for the first time in 2012-2013.

Celebrations from 2012-2013 Goals

- Lux students continue to achieve very high marks on NeSA assessments
- NeSA reading scores have been at or above the 90% proficient the last three years.
- In 2012/2013, Lux students were 95% proficient. This was our highest result.
 - For the last three years, eighth grade math NeSA scores have increased.
