- *All staff set professional learning appraisal goals and participate in professional development to improve their instructional skills*
 - *Lux demographics have changed and will change*
 - *Enrollment is at an all-time high*
- *PLC groups will focus on sub-groups who have not met AYP goals (special education and free-reduced lunch). The free and reduced lunch subgroup did not meet AYP for the first time in 2012-2013.*

Celebrations from 2012-2013 Goals

- *Lux students continue to achieve very high marks on NeSA assessments*
- *NeSA reading scores have been at or above the 90% proficient the last three years.*
- *In 2012/2013, Lux students were 95% proficient. This was our highest result.*
- *For the last three years, eighth grade math NeSA scores have increased.*
