All staff set professional learning goals and participate in professional development to improve their instructional skills.

Celebrations from 2012-2013 Goals

 3^{rd} and 5^{th} grade students raised ITBS scores in total reading and total math mean NCE by 4-6 percentile points.

81% of students in grades 3-5 met or exceeded the NeSA Math Standards. This was an increase of 2% from the previous year.

86% of 5th grader students met or exceeded the NeSA Science Standards. This was an increase of 24% from the previous year.
