Celebrations from 2012-2013 Goals

*3rd and 5th grade students raised ITBS scores in total reading and total math mean
NCE by 4-6 percentile points.*

increase of 2% from the previous year.*

*86% of 5th grader students met or exceeded the NeSA Science Standards. This was an
increase of 24% from the previous year.*
