School Improvement Most Important Points

All teachers use formative, district and state assessment data to identify areas of strength and need for individual students.

With a 45% change in staff within the past two years, Rousseau has focused on building community among staff and has increased collaboration within teams as well as collaboration school-wide.

Student diversity has had a positive impact on the building climate at Rousseau. We are moving towards a population that is more reflective of our Lincoln community.

Celebrations from 2012-13 Goals

The 5th grade increased the percentage of students proficient in NeSA-Science from 73% in 2011-12 to 83% in 2012-13 ranking them second among the elementary schools in the district.

On 2012-13 NeSA-R, 93% of the 3rd, 4th and 5th grade students were proficient.

In third and fifth grade, all seven subgroups (disaggregated data) scored similar to the student average on the 2012-13 NeSA-R.
