School Improvement Most Important Points

All building PLCs have included and are working on a SMART Goal related to improving reading comprehension. This also includes those staff members (Academic Connection Teachers) who meet with their PLC in another building.

We have made a strong effort to include a presentation of School Improvement at monthly Staff Meetings.

Building Professional Development (Flex) has focused around strategies and interventions for improving reading comprehension.

Celebrations from 2012-2013 Goals

Scott Middle School NeSA Reading scores have improved by 7% since 2009. (From 84% to 91% proficiency).

We have focused on our Special Education students in the area of reading. Our Special Education NeSA scores have improved by 11% since 2009. (From 43% to 54% proficiency).

In 2012-2013 our school met AYP in all areas. If we can repeat this for 2013-2014 we will move from being a school that "Needs Improvement" to "Met".
