Grade level teams have continued to refine PLC practices.

PLC teams are embarking upon learning the data team process to become more strategic in addressing student achievement.

Students embrace the SIP goals of the school and set individual goals for reaching school improvement benchmarks

## Celebrations from 2012-2013 Goals

Eighty-nine percent of  $3^{rd}$ - $5^{th}$  grade students scored proficient on the NeSA math test.

Ninety-two percent of the fourth grade students scored proficient on the fourth grade state writing test and twenty percent of the students scored in the "exceeds" range. The average scaled score of Zeman students was greater than that of the state and district students.

Ninety-one percent of the  $3^{rd}$ - $5^{th}$  grade students scored proficient on the NeSA reading test. Each year since 2009 the percentage of students scoring proficient on the NeSA R has increased.
