### School Improvement Most Important Points

- The Brownell CSIP Team meets monthly to review our school improvement goals and staff development needs to meet goals.
- The Brownell staff focuses on building goals by using the Data Teams Process where teams set short-term goals based on standards.
- CSIP strategies for math and reading are focused around engagement: math talk, collaborative conversation, stories and cooperative learning.

### Celebrations from 2013-2014 Goals

- **Brownell NeSA Reading scores increased from 78% students proficient in 2013 to 83% in 2014 for grades 3<sup>rd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup>.**
- **Brownell NeSA Math scores increased from 80% proficient in 2013 to 83% in 2014 grades 3<sup>rd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup>.**
- **Brownell 4<sup>th</sup> grade NeSA Writing scores increased from 56% students proficient in 2013 to 73% in 2014.**
