- All staff members participate in professional learning community meetings twice per month.
- All staff members serve on a school improvement committee, reflecting a strong belief that we are all responsible for school improvement.
- The Hill staff utilizes the data team process and research-based practices to provide a challenging, intentional and engaging instructional program for students.

Celebrations from 2013-2014 Goals

- 90% or more of students at grades 3,4, and 5 met or exceeded state standards in reading.
- 94% of math students in fourth grade met or exceeded state math standards.
- All subtests of the Iowa Test of Basic Skills administered in October of 2013 show Hill students consistently scoring at or above the LPS district average.
