- All grade level teams have moved to the Data Teams Model for School Improvement.
- Staff meet regularly in Professional Learning Communities to collaborate, evaluate data and improve instruction.
- Staff met in the summer of 2014 to participate in the "Adaptive Schools Seminar Training."
- Staff has embraced the PBiS model for behavior intervention.
- Quarterly instructional conferences, monthly PLC's, and weekly team meetings help teachers and administrators to stay focused on their school improvement goals and to work together to meet the needs of all students.

Celebrations from 2013-2014 Goals

- Kahoa NeSA scores exceeded the district standards
- In Math as demonstrated on the NeSA, 98% of students in grade 3 met/exceeded the standard.
- In Reading as demonstrated on the NeSA, 97% of students in grade 3 met/exceeded the standard.
