### Celebrations from 2013-2014 Goals

- 96% of Kloefkorn 3<sup>rd</sup> graders met or exceeded the standards on NeSA-Reading, compared to 80% at the state level and 82% for Lincoln Public Schools
- 94% of Kloefkorn 3<sup>rd</sup> graders met or exceeded the standards on NeSA-Math, compared to 76% at the state level and 81% for Lincoln Public Schools
- 98% of Kloefkorn 4<sup>th</sup> graders met or exceeded the standards on NeSA-Reading, compared to 78% at the state level and 82% for Lincoln Public Schools
- 96% of Kloefkorn 4<sup>th</sup> graders met or exceeded the standards on NeSA-Writing
- 98% of Kloefkorn 4<sup>th</sup> graders met or exceeded the standards on NeSA-Math, compared to 78% at the state level and 83% for Lincoln Public Schools
- 88% of Kloefkorn 5<sup>th</sup> graders met or exceeded the standards on NeSA-Reading, compared to 77% at the state level and 81% for Lincoln Public Schools
- 88% of Kloefkorn 5<sup>th</sup> graders met or exceeded the standards on NeSA-Math, compared to 76% at the state level and 79% for Lincoln Public Schools
- 91% of Kloefkorn 5<sup>th</sup> graders met or exceeded the standards on NeSA-Science, compared to 73% at the state level and 69% for Lincoln Public Schools
