- All staff focus on our school improvement goals through their collaboration during Professional Learning Community work and weekly team meetings.
- All staff set professional learning goals and participate in professional development to improve their instructional skills.

Celebrations from 2013-2014 Goals

- 5th grade students raised their ITBS scores in reading comprehension, vocabulary and total math mean NCE by 2 percentile points.
- 83% of our students in grades 3-5 met or exceeded the NeSA Math Standards. This was an increase of 2% from the previous year.
- 76% of our 4th grade students met or exceeded the NeSA Writing Standards. This was an increase of 8% from the previous year.
