Celebrations from 2013-2014 Goals

- Student NeSA math scores in grades 3, 4, and 5 exceed district and state averages in all categories (number sense, geometric/measurement, algebraic reasoning, and data analysis/probability).
- Student NeSA reading scores in grades 3, 4, and 5 exceed district and state averages in all categories (vocabulary and comprehension).
- 94% of all 4th grade students met or exceeded standards on NeSA reading in the spring of 2014.
