WHO CAN APPLY?

A junior who is currently attending a Lincoln high school, who has taken or will be enrolled in at least two of the following courses: Introduction to Health Occupations; Medical Terminology; Anatomy/ Physiology; Fundamentals of Health Careers

COST?

None. Saint Elizabeth Foundation will be underwriting the cost of this internship. The student will be responsible for providing their own transportation to the internship sites. At the successful completion of the six-week internship, students will be awarded up to an \$800 stipend. LPS students can use the experience for community service hours for Government and Politics.

STUDENT CONDUCT

Students will be expected to follow Summer Internship guidelines as determined by Saint Elizabeth Regional Medical Center and other site locations. These guidelines will be discussed at the orientation meeting for selected applicants.
