School Improvement Most Important Points

- PLC teams will understand the Instructional Planning Framework and utilize the nine instructional strategy categories from Classroom Instruction that Works.
- PLC Teams will meet twice monthly during the 2014-2015 school year.
- PLC Leadership Team with one representative from each PLC team will meet once a month to further staff development, increase communication and vertical teaming.
- PLC Teams will utilize a standard agenda outlining the Data Teams process.
- A particular focus will be placed on Special Education students and students who qualify for free and reduced lunch as achievement of students in these subgroups lag behind overall student achievement results.

Celebrations from 2013-2014 Goals

- In Math as demonstrated on the NeSA, 94% of students in grade 3 met/exceeded the standard.
- In Reading as demonstrated on the NeSA, 91% of students in grade 3 met/exceeded the standard.
- Kooser NeSA scores exceeded the district standards
